Recognizing cognates

Cognates are words that share similar meanings and spellings in two or more languages. When reading in French, it's helpful to look for cognates and use them to guess the meaning of what you're reading. However, watch out for false cognates. For example, *librairie* means *bookstore*, not *library*, and *coin* means *corner*, not *coin*. Look at this list of French words. Can you guess the meaning of each word?


